From Sky Harbor International Airport

Take the 202 East to merge onto the 101 North. Exit at Indian Bend Road and turn right.

From the northwest Valley

Take the 101 North toward Scottsdale. Exit at Indian Bend Road and turn left.

From the southwest Valley

Take the I-10 West toward Phoenix. Merge onto the 202 East. After approximately nine miles, merge onto the 101 North. Exit at Indian Bend Road and turn right.

From the East Valley

Take the US-60 West toward Phoenix. Merge onto the 101 North toward Scottsdale. Exit at Indian Bend Road and turn right.
